Soldiers set Imam Husain's tents on fire.



Nowadays, millions of people pay their respects to Imam Husain at the mosque built over his grave.

Although Imam Husain died on the plains of Karbala, his stand against injustice will live on as long there are tyrants and people to stand up against them.




Imam Husain's eldest son, Imam Ali Zain-ul Abideen becomes severely ill before the battle.

After brave fighting, many of Imam Husain's companions are martyred.



Abbas, the flagbearer of Imam Husain, goes to fetch water for the children. He is martyred.
